



INTERNATIONAL POLICE HOCKEY TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE

PARTICIPATION and CONDUCT RULES

Participation is restricted to:

- Active Police Officers
- Retired Police Officers
- Full-time civilian employees of a Police Service
- Peace Officers (eg: Fire Marshalls) - Grandfathered or with the approval of the International Committee
- Identification checks will be conducted during the Tournament

Conduct

- Zero tolerance of any abuse of Referees or Tournament Volunteers or Arena Convenors by any team player, coach or other member of a team
- Teams are expected to show up for ALL their scheduled games
- Tournament participants are expected to conduct themselves in a professional manner on and off the ice

In the past two years, two teams have been disqualified for one year from the International Tournament, for abuse of referees and volunteer staff or failing to show up for their scheduled games. This conduct will not be tolerated and will be addressed by the International Committee in a timely manner.
